Custodial history

This collection was considered part of the Visual Resources Collections at the School of Architecture. The VR collections were systematically weeded between 2008-2009, the process by which original photography was identified and kept, and the removal of copy-stand images from books and some commercial slides. The Robert Bradford Browne slide collection was kept on-site at the Architecture Library for further processing.

Scope and content

Robert Bradford Browne was a Coconut Grove architect noted for his distinctive designs of tropical homes and buildings.

Born in Jacksonville, he graduated from The University of Florida School of Architecture, and moved to Miami in 1952.

Browne served as chief architect and coordinator of the Inter-American Cultural Trade Center (Interama) project in the 1960s.
