Scope and content

Gertrude Jobs was born in Brooklyn, N.Y. in 1907, and is the author of a number of books including *One Happy Family*; *Dictionary of Mythology, Folklore and Symbols*; *Outer Space*; and *The Motion Picture Empire*. She often contributed her poetry to anthologies and avant-garde journals. She later resided in Miami, Florida.

The Gertrude Jobs Collection contains typescripts and manuscripts by Gertrude Jobs. Included is an undated and unpublished 91 page typescript titled *The Patriot and the Traitor: a tragi-comedy in three acts*, an undated and unpublished typescript titled *Tigers in the Bamboo Grove*, assorted prose writings, and assorted poetry. Also included is biographical and genealogical data on Jobs, a sketch of Jobs, and correspondence from the years 1965-1969, chiefly on the subject of the illness and death of her husband James A. Jobs.
