Note

Mortar Board began as the first-ever national organization honoring senior college women. AT UM it began in 1937 as another organization known as Nu Kappa Tau, which was regarded as the highest honor given to women during the time that Iron Arrow was restricted to men. In 1966 its members chose to affiliate with the national women's honor society and Nu Kappa Tau became Mortar Board. In 1975 membership was open to male students. Today it is a national honor society that recognizes college seniors for their achievements in scholarship, leadership, and service.

This collection includes reports, bylaws, membership lists, and other miscellaneous items of Mortar Board, which is an honor society of senior students of the University of Miami.
