Administrative history / Biographical sketch

Note

The Industrial Education Department is now part of the the College of Engineering. The College grew out of an engineering science major in the College of Arts and Sciences from 1942 to 1947, when the Board of Trustees established the School of Engineering with Professor John H. Clouse as Dean. It opened with the electrical, industrial, and mechanical engineering departments, followed by civil in 1948 and architectural in 1950. The school was housed in the old Anastasia Building in the first 12 years, then moved to the McArthur Bilding on Main Campus in 1959.

Scope and content

This collection contains 9 black and white promotional photographs of classes taught in the Industrial Education Department of the University of Miami in 1951. The photographs show classes in bookbinding, printing, working with plastics and sheetmetal, welding, and woodworking. The size of the photos are 7.5 x 9.5 inches glued on 8 x10 inch mats.

In addition, there are two press articles about the department (1954 and 1955) and brochures promoting the profession of industrial art teacher (no date).
