The 75-page student publication "Hope amid chaos: an architectural plan for South Dade" was completed during the Fall Semester, 1992 by a class of 12 students at the School of Architecture, University of Miami.

Administrative history / Biographical sketch

Note

Courses in architecture were offered at the University of Miami as early as 1927. Department of Architecture was created in the School of Engineering and Environmental Design in 1964. By 1983, after President Tad Foote's arrival, the architecture program became independent from the School of Engineering and developed into the School of Architecture. Elizabeth Plater-Zyberk became a member of the architecture faculty in 1979 and was appointed the dean of the school in 1995.

Scope and content

The collection contains publications and organizational records of the University of Miami's School of Architecture, such as the official newsletter "UM arch.," promotional postcards, Jorge M. Perez Architecture Center founded in 2005, and architectural work by students.
