### Scope and content

The Olga Espejo Facsimile Map Collection consists of photo reproductions of rare maps held by the Special Collections of Otto G. Richter Library used for her 1995 publication "The West Indies and Florida to 1900: an annotated carto-bibliography." The collection was donated by the author to the University Archives in June 2015.

The Special Collections holds more than 3,000 maps, charts, plans, and views, which dates from the sixteenth to the twentieth centuries and covers nearly all areas of the world, with an emphasis on what was then termed the New World, including Florida, the Caribbean, Latin America, and the United States.
