BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Luisa Muñoz del Valle was born in Sancti Spiritus, Las Villas, Cuba on June 4, 1906 of Luis Muñoz Valdés and Francisca del Valle González. She was baptized Luisa María Juana Muñoz del Valle. She started her education at the Colegio San Francisco Javier in Sancti Spiritus. She started her studies in education at the Escuelas Normales de Santa Clara, Las Villas and completed them in the Escuelas Normales de la Habana, receiving her degree in 1930.

She taught in private schools from 1930-1938 while studying for her doctorate. She later went on to complete her doctorate in Pedagogy at the University of Havana, receiving her degree the 18th of November, 1937. During this time she had already started her poetry. Her first major award as a poetess was at the Juegos Florales in Sancti Spiritus where she was awarded the Flor Natural (First Prize) for her poem, "Civilización Occidental" in 1934. In 1935, encouraged by Cuban poets Andrés de Piedra-Bueno and José Angel Buesa, she published her only book of poetry: Angelus.

In 1936, she received national recognition when her poem "Romance de la Virgen de la Caridad" won third place at the Eucharistic Congress and Coronation of Our Lady of Charity. From this point on, she published her poems frequently in magazines such as San Antonio, Azul, El Fénix, La Milagrosa, and Semanario Católico with which she had collaborated since 1928.

Fulfilling an interest she had in journalism, Luisa Muñoz completed studies in journalism at the Escuela Profesional de Periodismo "Manuel Marquez Sterling" in 1950, graduating first in her class, the first time a woman had done so. After spending a year studying in Spain with a scholarship received from the Ministry of Education, she started working as a journalist, particularly for iAlerta!, where she edited the daily Catholicism column.

Luisa Muñoz worked less after the Revolution since many newspapers were closed down by the policies of the Castro regime. She chose, however, to remain in Cuba instead of escaping to exile like the rest of her family. She stayed living in Havana, publishing her poems whenever possible, but increasingly her health weakened. Her family in Miami, particularly her brother Dr. Luis B. Muñoz del Valle, tried to convince her to leave during the Mariel exodus in 1980 but she refused because she felt she would burden her family too much. Her health continued to deteriorate until her death on August 2, 1987.

DESCRIPTION OF THE PAPERS

The personal papers of Luisa Muñoz del Valle were donated to the University of Miami Library's Archives and Special Collections Department by her brother, Dr. Luis Muñoz del Valle, in 1991. Friends of Luisa Munoz del Valle mailed materials to Dr. Munoz over a period of three years, following the death of Luisa Muñoz. Luisa Muñoz del Valle was a noted Cuban poet and reporter. She was active in many organizations, including the Catholic Action.

The Papers consist of three boxes of materials and total 1.50 cubic feet. The approximate number of pages in the Papaers is 400, and there are six photogrpahs. Access to the Papers is unrestricted. Of primary importance in the Papers is the poetry of Luisa Muñoz del Valle, most of it unpublished outside of Cuba.

SERIES DESCRIPTION

Series I: Poetry and Prose Works, 1926-1959

Arranged alphabetically by title.

This series contains the poetry (box 1) and prose (box 2) works of Luisa Muñoz del Valle from such Cuban publications as Azul, Semanario Católico, La Quincena, San Antonio, Alerta, and El Fénix.

Series II: Subject Files, 1934- 1987

Arranged alphabetically.

This series includes books, publications, clippings, typescripts, and photographs. Among items of interest are copies of *Angelus* (box 3, folder 1); hymns written by Muñoz del Valle (box 3, folder 10); and photographs (box 3, folder 13).
