SERIES I: SOURCES/CORRESPONDENCE, includes letters and documents solicited and compiled by Virginia Spencer Carr. The individual files are maintained as received from the compiler. The following notes provide information on the types of materials present for each correspondent.

<u>Letters</u>

- * The number before the slash mark indicates the number of letters from Virginia Spencer Carr (or her research assistant Maxine Brown) to the subject, and the number after the slash indicates the number of letters from the subject to Carr.
- Following these designations, the dates of Carr letters are listed on the left, and dates and descriptions of subjects' letters to Carr are listed on the right.
- * All Carr letters are carbon copies of typescript correspondence.
- Unless otherwise noted, all letters from subjects are 1 p. long.
- * The following legend applies for subjects' letters:

<u>Other</u>

- * "Notes" are by Carr/Brown on the subject under which they are listed, and are handwritten unless otherwise indicated
- Clippings are largely from contemporary (1970s) newspapers or magazines and are concerned with the subject under which they are listed
- * Items of particular interest are listed in **bold**.

SERIES II: SUBJECT FILES, contains extensive research notes, photocopies of original documents and other materials compiled in the course of research on the life of John Dos Passos. The selection of subject headings and the location of materials within files is maintained in original order.
